How to remember the Parish of Esher in your Will

The Parish of Esher (Parochial Church Council of Esher) is a Christian charity, and is part of the Church of England. The church's call to mission is as Jesus said when he stood up in his hometown Synagogue.



Jesus unrolled the scroll and found the place where it was written: The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he has anointed me to bring Good News to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim release to captives and recovery of sight to the blind, to let the oppressed go free, to proclaim the year of the Lord's favour. (Luke 4:17b-19)

It is quite simply transforming the world, and by remembering Esher parish in your will you will be helping this happen in Esher. There are four simple things you would need to do:

- 1. Choose a good Solicitor to help you write or change your Will.
- 2. Decide which of the following three types of legacy you wish to leave to Esher Parish, and use the right phrase for your Will.
- 3. Give the phrase you have chosen to your Solicitor.
- 4. Let us know you have included us in your Will.

Types of Will

1. Residuary Legacy (leaving the remainder or a share of your estate to Esher Parish, after all other provisions have been made:

"I give free of inheritance tax and all other fiscal impositions all (or a share of) the residue of my estate absolutely to Parochial Church Council of Esher, Registered Charity No. 113487 for its general purposes and I direct that the receipt of the Director or other duly authorised officer shall be sufficient to discharge my executors".

2. Pecuniary Legacy (leaving a fixed amount to Esher Parish)

"I give Parochial Church Council of Esher, Registered Charity No. 113487 the sum of

£ (in figures)

£ (in words) for its general purposes and I direct that the receipt of the Director or other duly authorised officer shall be sufficient to discharge my executors".

3. Specific Legacy (leaving a specific item to Esher Parish)

"I give, free of inheritance tax and all other fiscal impositions to Parochial Church Council of Esher, Registered Charity No. 113487, my (*description of property*) absolutely for the general purposes of such Charity and I direct that the receipt(s) of the Director or other duly authorised officer shall be sufficient to discharge my executors".
