from whose love in Christ we cannot be parted,
either by death or by life:
hear our prayers and thanksgivings
for all whom we remember this day;
fulfil in them the purpose of your love;
and bring us, with them, to your eternal joy;
through Jesus Christ our Lord.

Amen.

The clergy and choir then lead the procession into the church, where the congregation take their seats in silence.
