Christ Church and St George's Church are an enduring presence and have been, and continue to be, open to all at every stage of life from baptisms to weddings and funerals. It may come as a surprise that no central funding is available to help parishes maintain churches across the land: church buildings are maintained by parishioners making voluntary donations, and the Parish of Esher is no exception. Without this generosity our Parish could not function and our buildings would fall into disrepair. Becoming a Friend will help us preserve our two beautiful church buildings so they can continue to serve Esher and West End for many more years. It will enable us to promote both churches so they can grow and become focal points of the local community, making our church buildings and facilities available for a range of activities and events to encourage closer community cohesion and cooperation. A little history lesson...

Christ Church, completed in 1854, was designed in the Victorian Gothic style. Queen Victoria had strong connections with it, firstly through her uncle Prince Leopold, King of the Belgians and secondly through her youngest son, the Duke of Albany, both of whom resided at Claremont. The organ loft was once a royal pew and several monuments and stained glass windows inside are dedicated to the nobility, while in the churchyard there are many historic graves.

St George's in West End is a tin tabernacle church and was built as a temporary structure in 1879 on land donated by Queen Victoria to give servants and farm labourers from the Royal Estate of Claremont a place of worship. This little iron church has now stood for over 140 years.

Use Gift Aid and you can make your donation worth more. For every pound you give us, we get an extra 25p from Her Majesty's Revenue & Customs. Just fill in the form on the reverse.

- want to cancel your Gift Aid declaration
- change your name or address
- no longer pay sufficient tax on your income or capital gains.
