Biographical Note



The Galliard Trio, whose members live within a short distance of each other in north London, was formed forty-four years ago. Since then, it has been giving concerts throughout southern England, in music clubs, stately homes, churches, schools and arts centres. It sometimes performs in support of good causes such as the National Trust, church restoration funds and other charities. This is the Trio's second visit to Esher following their debut performance for Music on the Green in 2019.

The Trio has established a reputation for programmes of great variety. Its repertoire is wide, partly because of the different combinations of instruments available and partly because of arrangements which its own members have made of music by a diverse array of composers.

The Trio has recorded some of its favourite pieces on two CDs, which are available for purchase today.
