

## Parish of Esher Map & Directions

Please find below a map and some suggestions on travelling to Christ Church, Esher and St George's Church, West End within the Parish of Esher.

### Christ Church

Church Street, Esher KT10 8QS

Christ Church is on Church Street, which is a short road but part of a busy one-way system around Esher town centre.

#### By car

The easiest way to the church is from the A3. Take the A224/Copsem Lane towards Esher. Continue straight to reach the centre of Esher and shops. Keep to the left as you cross two sets of traffic lights quite close together. Keep straight ahead as you cross the intersection. Stay in the left lane as you enter Church Street and turn left into the church near the end of the street.

#### Parking

There is parking at Christ Church for only about eight cars. On-street parking in Esher is also limited and it might be simpler to use one of the local public car parks. Highwaymans Cottage Car Park, KT10 9LG, for example, can be accessed from Claremont Lane and the walk to the church takes about five minutes. There is a large car park at the Elmbridge Civic Centre KT10 9RA.

#### By train

Esher station is on the Waterloo to Guildford line known as 'Guildford via Weybridge'. The station is just over a mile from Christ Church. Taxis are available at the station. You can also travel to Claygate station from Waterloo on the 'Guildford via Cobham' line. Claygate station is about 1.5 miles from Christ Church. Again there are taxis available at the station.

### St George's Church

West End Lane, West End, Esher KT10 8LF

St George's, West End is on West End Lane opposite an open area and sports ground called West End Green and near Garsons Farm. The church, near West End Village Hall, should not be confused with 'old' St George's Church in Esher KT10 9PX, which is in the care of the Churches Conservation Trust.

#### By car

Coming from the Esher direction on the A307/Portsmouth Road, turn right on to Hawkshill Way and then left on to West End Lane at the bottom of the hill. Bear left opposite the Prince of Wales pub, keeping the pond on your right. The church will be on your left. Coming from Cobham towards Esher on the A307/Portsmouth Road, turn left onto West End Lane. From the Hersham direction, on the A244 towards Esher, turn right at the roundabout just after the bridge over the River Mole, on to West End Lane. Follow West End Lane past the Prince of Wales, bearing left with the pond on your right.

#### Parking

There is no car park by the St George's but cars can be parked on West End Lane.

#### By train

Taxis from Esher or Claygate stations are advised.
